For the reason that universal fit forklift buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the machinery and are a lot less susceptible to destruction. These buckets are even 50 percent deeper compared to the quick-tach bucket models. This additional space makes them perfect for lifting irregular shaped loads like for example moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing of roof trash and elevating roof gravel.
